"Where your Heart is..." is a
 discipleship spirituality program that
 offers parishioners who are looking to
 deepen their spiritual life a roadmap or
 guide to help them continue their
 spiritual faith journey.

Program Objectives:

The program seeks to enable participants to:

- A. Encounter Jesus in a new way in their day to day life experiences and help them respond to his invitation to bring about God's Kingdom as fully engaged members of the discipleship community.
- B. Discern the meaning and ***purpose of life's trials and difficulties as part of life's continuing faith journey.***
- C. Promote the joyful message of the gospel with greater conviction amidst the complexities of life and human struggles.

Program Components:

There will be two parts to the program.

I. Discipleship Spirituality Introductory Retreat Workshop (October 15, 2016 from 9 am - 4 pm at John 1 & 2, at The Venetian. Registration begins at 8:30 a.m. A continental breakfast and a light lunch will be served.) This introductory workshop will lay the foundation for the ***"Where your Heart is..."*** Discipleship Spirituality Program.

Workshop Topics:

1. Discipleship Spirituality as a Faith Journey
2. The Three Movements of Spiritual Life
3. Stages of Discipleship

II. - ICHTHYS - (Discipleship Community Groups) (Weekly sessions beginning week of October 24, 2016) The ICHTHYS (Discipleship Community Group) is designed for individuals who are committed to pursuing their spiritual journey with a community of disciples. Participation in the ICHTHYS requires attendance at the Introductory Retreat Workshop. The members commit to the program for 16 weeks.

After this, the group can renew their covenant with each other for the rest of the year. These sessions will be more in depth and will involve a more intense, directed/guided process, as you continue your faith journey through Discipleship Community Groups.
