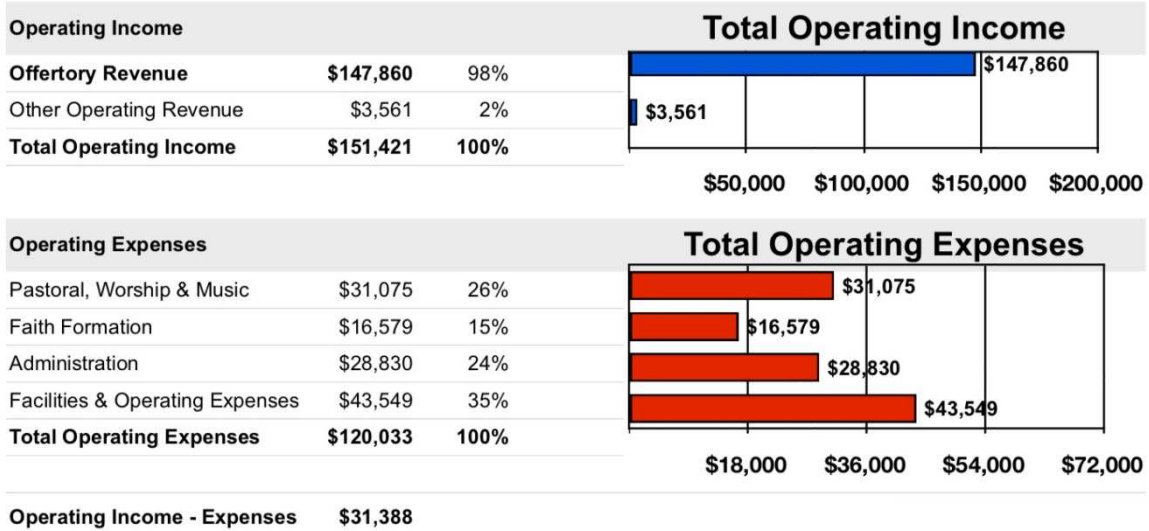

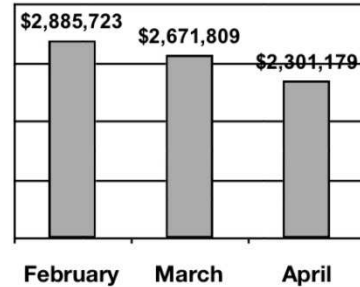

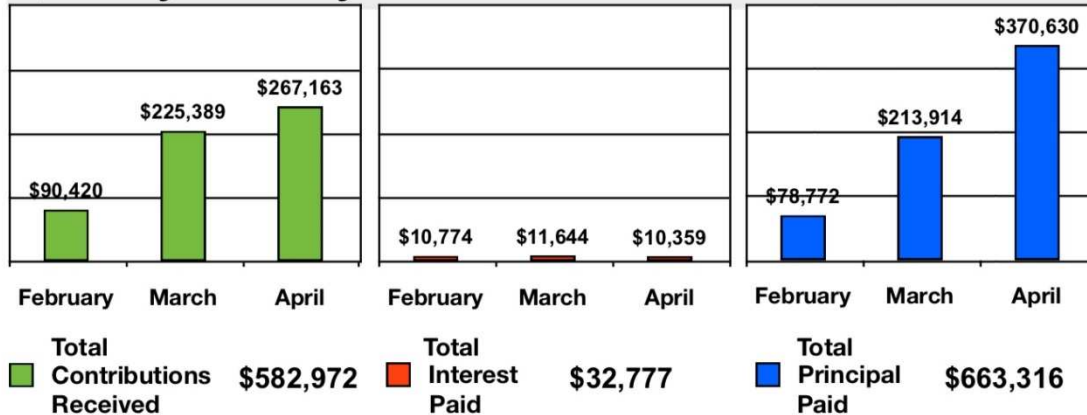

## Diocese of St. Petersburg - APA & Forward in Faith

**What is the Annual Pastoral Appeal (APA)?**

Each year, all of the parishes in the Diocese of St. Petersburg are assessed roughly 13% of their combined parish revenues (offertory collections) to fund the operating budget of our diocesan level ministries and services which serve its five counties.

The Annual Pastoral Appeal (APA), managed by the Diocese of St. Petersburg, is the annual fundraiser or appeal initiated in January by a mailing pledge cards to all of the parishioners of each parish inviting them to contribute directly toward helping their specific parish pay its yearly APA required assessment.

The requirement is for each parish to reach their assessment amount (*optimally through pledge contributions or one time donations*).

However, **if the goal is not met, the balance due must be paid out of the parish's operating funds** (which are the offertory collections which fund their operating budgets).
