As a member of the Titan family, you will be expected to follow the guidelines outlined in our elementary, junior high and high school handbooks. These rules have been established to help ensure that all students are provided with an educational environment that fosters intellectual, spiritual, and physical growth. We expect students to share in creating a healthy, moral atmosphere by living those Gospel values taught by our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We expect students to respect others and to take their studies seriously. Motivated by the Gospel, our fundamental purpose is to prepare you for the world with the goal of attaining everlasting happiness in heaven. Our mission is to set the Standard for this generation of youth.

Please read the applicable handbook carefully and completely. It is the responsibility of each student and parent/guardian to know the substance of all the information, policies, and regulations. Being unaware of these rules can never be accepted as an excuse for its violation.

Below are Permissions necessary for attendance at the Trinity Catholic Schools. If you do not return this sheet within ten (10) school days from students first day of attendance, your child will be asked to withdraw.

EMERGENCY RELEASES

In case of emergency and parents or emergency contacts cannot be reached I give my doctor or any attending physician permission to administer medical treatment.

In an emergency situation, I hereby give permission to call an ambulance to transport my child to the nearest hospital if parents or emergency contacts cannot be reached.

SHARING OF STUDENT PHOTOS & INFORMATION

Throughout the school year, there may be times when Trinity staff, the media, or other organizations, with the approval of the school principal, may take photographs of students, audio/videotape students, or interview students for school related stories in a way that would individually identify a specific student. Those photographs and/or videotaped images or interviews may appear in District/School publications, in District/School video productions, on the District/School website, on District authorized social networking sites such as Facebook or Twitter, in the news media, or in other organizations' school related stories or articles.

I hereby grant unto Trinity permission to use my child's photograph and/or videotaped image or interview for the purposes mentioned above. I understand and agree that Trinity may use these photos and/or videotaped images or interviews in subsequent school years unless I revoke this authorization by notifying the school principal in writing. I further grant unto Trinity permission to permit my child to be photographed, audio/videotaped, or interviewed by the news media or other organizations for school related stories or articles.

Specific directory information such as student's name, address, telephone listing, date and place of birth, major field of studies, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height as member of athletic teams, dates of attendance, degrees and awards received, and the most recently previous school attended by the student, may be released by the school officials. The school district will make a reasonable decision whether or not to release information to various agencies or organizations.

However, any eligible student or a student's parent may request in writing during the first two weeks of school to their respective principal, if it is felt any part of the information or photos should not be released.

INTERNET STUDENT CONTRACT

I understand that the use of the internet is designed strictly for educational purposes. I also understand that Trinity Elementary East/Trinity Elementary West/Trinity Elementary North/Trinity Junior High and High School is taking measures to ensure that my child does not have access to materials deemed inappropriate and will not hold TEE/TEW/TEN/THS responsible for any inappropriate materials acquired. I have read and agree to the school's Acceptable Use Policy and I understand that I may be held responsible for violations by my child. I understand that some materials on the Internet may be objectionable, even though an intercept program is in the system. Therefore, I agree to accept responsibility for guiding my child, and conveying to him/her appropriate standards for selecting, sharing and/or exploring information and media.

As a student at Trinity I will abide by all requirements of the schools Acceptable Use Policy and understand that any violation will lead to possible loss of all computer privileges in addition to the added penalties of suspension or expulsion.
