2-Day Preschool (Tuesday and Thursday) Morning Session (8:00 AM to 11:00 AM) Afternoon Session (12:00 PM to 3:00 PM)	\$1,750	Child must be <b>3 BEFORE August 1</b> of enrollment year.
3-day Preschool (Monday, Wednesday, and Friday) Morning Session (8:00 AM to 11:00 AM) Afternoon Session (12:00 PM to 3:00 PM)	\$2,300	Child must <b>3 BEFORE August 1</b> of enrollment year.
4-day Preschool (Monday through Thursday, adding Fridays in March) Afternoon Session (12:00 PM to 3:00 PM)	\$2,800	Child must be <b>4 BEFORE August 1</b> of enrollment year.
Prekindergarten (Monday through Friday) Full Day (8:15 AM to 3:15 PM)	\$5,500	Child must be <b>4 BEFORE August 1</b> of enrollment year.

## *About our half-day preschool:*

- ◆ **Six, half-day sections of preschool are offered**, allowing families the flexibility to choose what works best for their schedule.
- ◆ Our half-day preschool is the only preschool in Dickinson to have earned the 3 star quality rating in the **Bright & Early ND Program**. This means our program goes above and beyond the basic licensing standards of North Dakota and has completed an intensive observation process to earn the 3 star quality rating.
- ◆ Preschool students are in an elementary school building, which allows them to experience how a school runs—things like the sound of school bells; how to line up in a hallway; recognizing familiar school faces; and the opportunity of working with an older student or “buddy” for special events or classroom projects.
- ◆ Our half-day preschool is licensed through Stark County Social Services, thus we are inspected for fire safety and are visited by the Stark County Licensor twice per year.
- ◆ **Milk and juice are offered** during snack time to the preschool students. This fee is charged separately in our online tuition management program, FACTS, and is as follows:  
**2-day milk/juice fee: \$35.00/year   3-day milk/juice fee: \$45.00/year   4-day milk/juice fee: \$68.00/year**
- ◆ Preschool students enrolled in the **4-day afternoon section are eligible for Trinity Extended Care** (our after-school care program). There is a separate fee for enrollment in afterschool care. For additional information, please contact the Trinity Catholic Schools Business Office, (701) 483-6081.
- ◆ Preschool students are not required to wear school standard dress apparel.
- ◆ To enroll in preschool, the child **must be toilet trained**.

## *About our prekindergarten:*

- ◆ Prekindergarten at Trinity Elementary School **operates within the time frame of a regular school day. Our day begins at 8:15 AM and ends at 3:15 PM. Students can be dropped off as early as 7:45 AM.**
- ◆ A day in prekindergarten includes ample time for lessons across all academic areas; bible study and prayer; reading and story time; music and movement; arts and crafts; physical education; and free play. There is also a scheduled afternoon rest time.
- ◆ **Milk and juice are offered** during snack time to the prekindergarten students. This fee is charged separately in our online tuition management program, FACTS, and is **\$80/year**.
- ◆ **Hot lunch is offered to our prekindergarten students.** This average fee is **\$65 per month**. This charge will also come through your FACTS account at the beginning of the new school year.
- ◆ **Prekindergarten students are eligible for Trinity Extended Care** (our afterschool care program). There is a separate fee for enrollment in afterschool care. For additional information, please contact the Trinity Catholic Schools Business Office, (701) 483-6081.
- ◆ Prekindergarten students are required to wear Trinity Elementary Standard Dress tops.
- ◆ To enroll in prekindergarten, the child **must be toilet trained**.
