# Theme Weeks:

Each week will be centered on a theme. Students will create theme related projects/crafts. In addition, each week we will be doing Bible lesson to strengthen our students' faith.

## **Week of May 28th-May 31st**

The first week of camp will include "get to know you" activities. We will be going over rules and expectations.

## **Friendship Week June 3rd- June 7th**

A good friend is a blessing from God! To start the summer, we will learn about what it means to be a true friend and how to enjoy the time we have with each other in a respectful and fun way.

Bible Lesson: This week we will learn how to use courteous communication. We will be learning how to respond with kindness and gentleness to others.



## **Dinosaur Week June 10 - June 14**

We will learn about these prehistoric animals - from the herbivores to the carnivores, and discovering what a paleontologist is and why they are important.

Fieldtrip: Dickinson Dinosaur Museum.
