St Frances Cabrini offers a ministry of grief support called Starting a New Life. Now in our 20th year, this ministry has helped people who have lost a loved one to death. It is a peer ministry, which means that all facilitators have experienced a loss, and can aid those in grief. This ministry offers this session to help people who have lost a spouse, a parent, a child, a relative, or a close friend to death. The major changes to this ministry is that meetings will be on SUNDAYS from 3-5 pm. (We used to meet on Tuesday evenings) This change will help those who do not wish to drive at night, and it can also benefit those who work, and cannot attend evening sessions during the week. This is a God-Centered ministry. During our 20-year history, many that have gone through our program have chosen to give back to the ministry. Their generosity has allowed Starting a New Life to offer this compassionate supportive ministry at no charge to the participants. If you know of someone who is suffering due to the death of a loved one, please refer them to this ministry, or even bring them Sunday March 5th to the first meeting.
