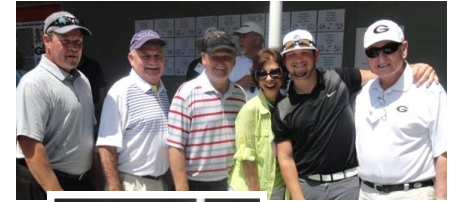
**REVIVAL FOR PARENTS & GRANDPARENTS**
