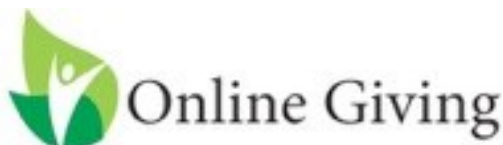

INTERFAITH HOSPITALITY NETWORK OF ATHENS

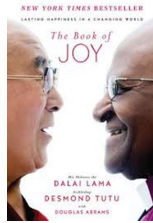
