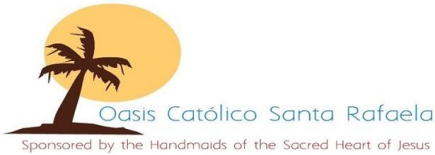
ARCHBISHOP GREGORY

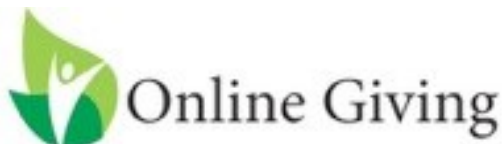
