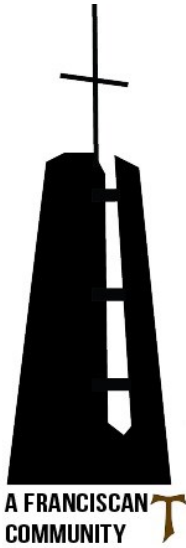

Hi everyone!

We would like to share some information about a unique opportunity for any student or community member at the Catholic Center to join or support **A Ride of Reconciliation. The Lakota Ride 2018: A Ride of Reconciliation** is a 400 mile horseback ride from Denver, Colorado to Pine Ridge, South Dakota starting July 14 to August 4. The ride is hosted by the Tipi Raisers, a non-profit organization whose mission is to build alliances and strengthen communities for people both on and off the Lakota Indian reservation and to ease the conditions of poverty for the Lakota people.

The purpose of **A Ride of Reconciliation** is to create positive, long term relationships between the Lakota people and those seeking to better understand the Lakota culture and history, and to raise critically needed funds for projects underway on the Reservation. Participants are invited to join the ride for one day, multiple days, or the whole trip! There is no entrance fee but each rider is asked to raise \$500.

We will be hosting a bake sale after all of the Masses the weekend of June 16-17, with all proceeds going toward **The Lakota Ride 2018**. If you would like to support the ride, please visit us at our bake sale.
