New Surroundings at the Center

Over Spring Break, our property was closed due to construction. During Lent, our flower beds behind the Children's Garden were completed with newly planted shrubbery and flowers, in addition to the complete construction project which included sidewalk replacement, patio replacement, handicap accessibility to the center, replacement of fences, rainwater run-off repair, and erosion prevention. The total cost of the construction projects was \$48,880. These funds were available from our Major Repairs and Renewal account. Thank you to those who have given to this account. The completion of this project was only made possible by the great stewardship this community has shown to the Catholic Center.
