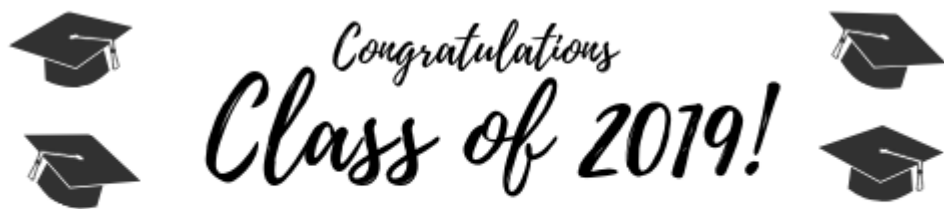

2019 5K Human Race

The 5K Human Race has been a Catholic Center fundraiser for 41 years and is our largest fundraiser to support CSA Activities and Ministries and our Franciscan Outreach Ministry. Many people gave their Time, Talents, and Treasures for this year's race to surpass previous years. Thanks to our: 47 business/family sponsors, 18 sponsors of 28 phantom runners, 214 individual runners, and numerous volunteers. This year our net profit was \$25,074.99!

New Surroundings at the Center

Over Spring Break, our property was closed due to construction. During Lent, our flower beds behind the Children's Garden were completed with newly planted shrubbery and flowers, in addition to the complete construction project which included sidewalk replacement, patio replacement, better handicap accessibility to the center, replacement of fences, rainwater run-off repair, and erosion prevention. The total cost of the construction projects was \$48,880. These funds were available from our Major Repairs and Renewal account. Thank you to those who have given to this account. The completion of this project was only made possible by the great stewardship this community has shown to the Catholic Center. VIDALIA ONION SALE MAY 11 AND MAY 12

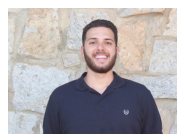
