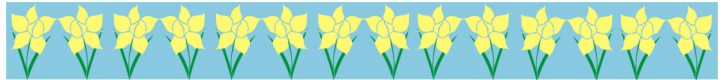


*Today, we open our hearts to the Hope, Joy and Promise that comes with Easter morning.*
