“Finally, the Church has been prepared for a movement of this nature by the decrees of the [First] Vatican Council on Papal authority, which has settled its rightful position, defined its exercise, and declared these decisions to be articles of the Catholic Faith. This elevation and settlement of the spiritual authority of the Church gave the main stroke to the main task of the Tridentine epoch, and has prepared the Church for a fresh start.” [On the Mission of New Religious Communities, 1876]
