## Ethics In Integrity Ministry: Basics & Refresher Workshop June 25, 2016

All persons serving in **any ministry requiring EIM compliance** (clergy, paid staff, volunteers working with youth and vulnerable adults, liturgical ministers, choir) must:

1. Complete the EIM Application for Ministry (one time only), which permits the diocese to run a background check and creates the EIM account where workshop attendance is recorded.
2. Attend an EIM workshop (Basic within 60 days of application submission) and within every 3 years thereafter.
