


# June 18th, 2017 The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ Corpus Christi Sunday

## A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

"The Lord be merciful to me and forgive all my offences. As I am finite I sin. Increases my finiteness that I might embrace more of Thee oh Lord. Infuse in my soul more and more of thy love. Oh may my souls capacities for thee be enlarged. Tho I am nothing yet will I be contented and satisfied if Thou willt fill my small vessel with thy Glory. If I would be greater it is that I might contain more of thy Love and Light. It is us oh Lord I know that place hindrences in our Souls to Thee. Lead me oh to remove them from thy Sight. Heavenly Father teach and counsel me as a child. May all presumption willfulness and worldly ambition be purged out of me with Thy pure love." [Diary, February 19, 1844]
