From the Pastor Regarding Finances

I want to report that our Parish is doing quite well. We seem to be increasing the number of registered parishioners and growing in numbers. Our finances are healthy and enabling us to make advanced payments on the principal of our loan from the diocese. We thank Brian Limoges for his leadership of the Finance Council. As his tenure has come to an end, we have had to search for another capable and willing parishioner to help us maintain the financial responsibilities of our parish. As of this week, Mark Bentley has accepted the challenge and is willing to serve. I thank him for his generosity. Coincidentally, together with the support of the Finance Council, I have decided to adjust our Fiscal year to match the Diocesan Fiscal year which starts on July 1st and ends June 30th. We have been on a calendar year, January 1 - December 31. This will enable us to better relate to the Diocesan records and reports. As a result, we are postponing our yearly financial report to the parish until sometime in early Fall. This will allow us to adjust our budget to the new fiscal year. Ethic & Integrity in Ministry- Austin Diocese

EIM compliance is required of all clergy, diocesan employees, parish employees, and adult lay persons who volunteer in ministry with minors or vulnerable adults, or in any ministry, program or organization that serves youth or vulnerable adults in any manner, or functions at a time and place where they are typically present. To be compliant, one submits an EIM Application for Ministry (one time only) and attends an EIM Workshop every three years.

If you have never completed an application, or are in need of attending a workshop to be compliant, please complete your application on the EIM Austin Diocese website.
