### Ethic & Integrity in Ministry- Austin Diocese

**EIM compliance is required** of all clergy, diocesan employees, parish employees, and adult lay persons who volunteer in ministry with minors or vulnerable adults, or in any ministry, program or organization that serves youth or vulnerable adults in any manner, or functions at a time and place where they are typically present. *To be compliant, one submits an EIM Application for Ministry (one time only) and attends an EIM Workshop every three years.*

If you have never completed an application, or are in need of attending a workshop to be compliant, please complete your application on the EIM Austin Diocese website. You can then register for one of the workshops, all are in English:

As a result, we are postponing our yearly financial report to the parish until sometime in early Fall. This will allow us to adjust our budget to the new fiscal year.
