EIM compliance is required of all clergy, diocesan employees, parish employees, and adult lay persons who volunteer in ministry with minors or vulnerable adults, or in any ministry, program or organization that serves youth or vulnerable adults in any manner, or functions at a time and place where they are typically present. *To be compliant, one submits an EIM Application for Ministry (one time only) and attends an EIM Workshop every three years.*

Coincidentally, together with the support of the Finance Council, I have decided to adjust our Fiscal year to match the Diocesan Fiscal year which starts on July 1st and ends June 30th. We have been on a calendar year, January 1 - December 31. This will enable us to better relate to the Diocesan records and reports. As a result, we are postponing our yearly financial report to the parish until sometime in early Fall. This will allow us to adjust our budget to the new fiscal year. "I must get back more to myself than of late I have been. Give more of my time to definite objects. Give more to silence, recollection, and calm thought. This it is that gives more depth & breadth to our spirit. The external is ever ephemeral and illusive. A hindered and distracted attention is soon wearied and is fruitless in results. The mind like a tree must be confined to a few branches if it would bear large and flavored fruit." [Diary, April 2, 1845]
