“The Lord – the Lord – the Lord – ah it is need that we call upon thee for help & consolation. I am nothing and ah what wouldst thou have me to do. ... Oh Lord help thou me in my dimness – make plain my path – open my eyes that I may see – give me grace that I may walk in thy way – Lord what shall I do? Thou art Almighty and all knowing. Give me oh Lord grace & wisdom.” [Diary, April 24, 1845]
