A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

“Lord I commit myself to Thee; reject oh not such a great sinner as I am. What can I do oh Lord could I but come to Thee. Lord help me in my troubles and let me not remain in darkness. Ah what am I thus to be so. Who will give me aid? Lord none but Thee. Come oh Jesus open Thou my eyes. Ah who will intercede for me? Oh Guardian Angel speak. I will have faith in God in all things.”
