Saint Oscar Romero

Blessed Oscar Romero will be canonized on *October 14, 2018*, in Rome, alongside Pope Paul VI, who gave Monsignor Romero unconditional support in a difficult time in El Salvador when the country was experiencing a civil war. When Oscar Romero was named Archbishop of San Salvador, he became the constant voice in defense of priests and the poor all during the conflict: a voice for peace and against violence. Archbishop Romero was gunned down at the altar while he was celebrating Mass. If Romero is named a Doctor, he will be the first Latin American Doctor of the Church.
