“Lord I am nothing. Give me Thy grace to enlighten me in my present darkness. Give me Thy grace of perseverance to embrace and continue in whatsoever Thou mayst call me. Lead me oh Lord in the way I should go. Let not my thoughts be distracted from this one thing in view. May all my attention be directed to this one point until Thou shalt enlighten me as to Thy purpose in my being.” [Diary, April 26, 1845]
