## A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

“Oh Lord I renew my promises made in baptism. I renounce the world the sense & the Devil and give myself wholly to Thee. Do with me oh Lord as seemeth good in Thy sight. I desire to overcome all self and be nothing else but thine alone. Help me oh Lord to overcome my self will. Whatsoever is in my way remove it oh Lord that I may see. Grant this oh Lord for the sake of Jesus and thy saints, miserere nobis.” [Diary, April 26, 1845]
