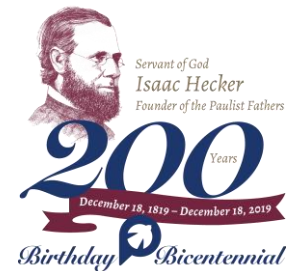
The Samaritan Grief Support Group

200 years, Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers
December 18, 1819 – December 18, 2019

Isaac Hecker's Experience of God

Servant of God Isaac Hecker, founder of the Paulist Fathers, was born December 18, 1819. Throughout 2019, we are celebrating the bicentennial of his birth. Here are some of Fr. Hecker's own words:

"Once in my childhood I was given over for death, having been taken down with the smallpox. My mother came to my bedside and told me that I was going to die. I answered her: "No, mother, I shall not die now; God has a work for me to do in the world, and I shall live to do it."
