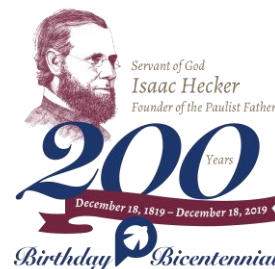
Men of Faith
