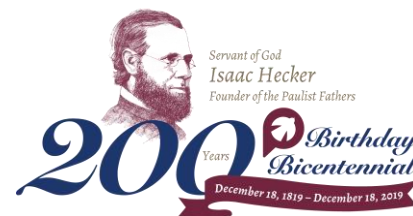

A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

“Yesterday, as I was praying the thought flashed across my mind. Where is God? Is he not here? Why prayest thou as if He is at a great distance from thee. Where canst thou place him. Think of it. Where canst thou place him. What locality? Is he not here in thy midst. Is his presence not nearest thee. Oh think of it. God is here. His presence is allways, universal and nearest. Am I impious to say that the language used in scripture for Christ’s expresses the thoughts of my soul. Oh could we but understand that the Kingdom of heaven is always at hand to the discerner.”
[Diary, April 20, 1843]
