Commissioning of Liturgical Ministers

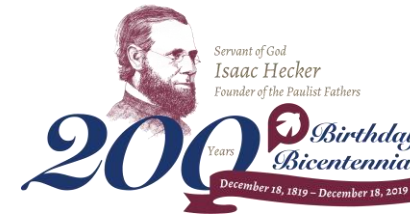

*Special Lenten Adult Faith Formation Opportunity

To understand our Catholic Faith, it is important to understand and appreciate its common roots with Judaism.
