First Aid Training

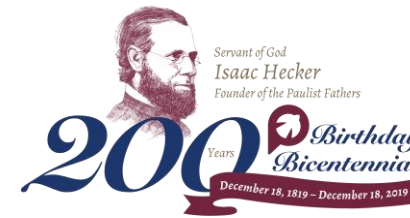

A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

The Bicentennial Year theme for February is Hecker's Search God (Reflected in his Diary, which he kept from January 1842 to July 1845)

"What the Lord will lead me to, for His presence is with me and directs my steps, what purpose or office or use, however humble, He may place me cannot be foreseen. Oh Lord, grant me humility, patience, peace and, above all, faith in they ever-loving Kindness. Oh give me calmness, restfulness in every trail of mind or body. [Diary, May 1844]
