Please Join Us for Stations of the Cross and our Parish Fish Fry

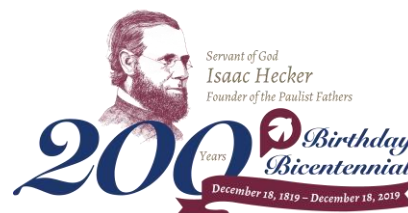
