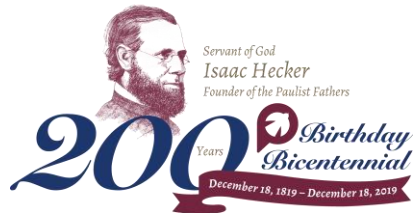

It has been a difficult and interesting past several months. Getting to a better understanding of what is going on is helpful. I met with my doctor earlier this week in Austin. First meetings can be long with information gathering. This was no different. He determined that he had an incomplete picture of my condition and so more tests were scheduled this past week. More blood tests, a PET scan and a bone marrow test were performed. Once he is able to study all of the results, he would be able to stage my cancer. Only then can a treatment plan be established. I meet with him next week. I want to thank all of you for your continued thoughts and prayers and many cards. I also ask your patience as I move through these coming weeks.
