From Fr Ruben

First, I want to wish you a very Happy Easter. The liturgies and decorations in our church this past week lead us to experience Christ's death and resurrection in such a beautiful and hopeful way. Thanks to all who helped. I also want to welcome Fr Charlie Brunick, CSP, who celebrated with us this past week. He is staying with me till May. I also want to apologize for not having mass on Palm Sunday. There was a technical communication problem.

Secondly, I was moved by the tragic fire at Notre Dame de Paris this past week. The pictures of the fire are horrifying. Fortunately, the relics, blessed sacrament and stained glass were saved. From the light shining through the rose window and the ashes of Notre Dame Cathedral, I see a sign. Beauty, order, harmony and most of all hope were not consumed by the fire.

Thirdly, I saw my doctor this Wednesday, April 17. The testing that he did last week (PET scan, blood, bone marrow) confirmed my condition. I have stage 2 Hodgkin's lymphoma, which is good news. He also has the base data he needs to follow the progress of my treatment. And most importantly we discussed the treatment plan and schedule. I have a few preparatory appointments this next week. I have my first treatment on Monday, April 29th. I am both anxious and relieved at the same time. I am finally getting on with the treatment. There is hope.

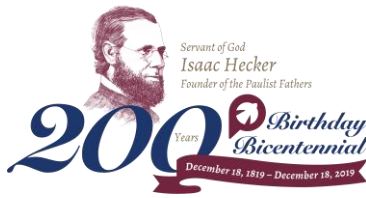
