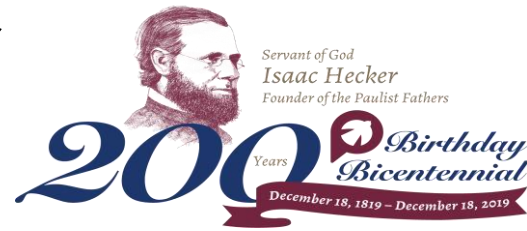

From Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers (1819 – 1888)

“Religion has nothing to fear from the “uncoverings of science”; for these will not prove in opposition to her divinely revealed truths, not identical with them, but will only serve to show more clearly their divine character and origin and their necessity.” (The Saint of Our Day, Sermon about St. Joseph) In another place, Fr. Hecker writes, “For God is no less the author of nature than of grace, of reason than of faith, of this earth than of heaven.” (*Church and the Age*. P. 60)
