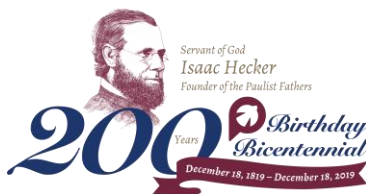
Blessings on the 40th Anniversary of Your Ordination, May 19, 2019
