We have exceeded our Encountering Christ Campaign goal!!! We have raised pledges totaling \$605,572 and our goal was \$545,000. Of this amount our Parish will receive \$205,000 over the pledge period of 5 years. This is very exciting news.

I want to extend my sincere thanks to everyone who contributed in prayer and/or financial contribution to our Encountering Christ Campaign. We have about one week remaining in the campaign. We receive 70 percent of each new pledge since we have surpassed our goal.

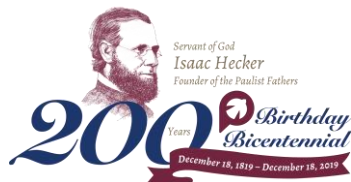
