### **Music Director Position**

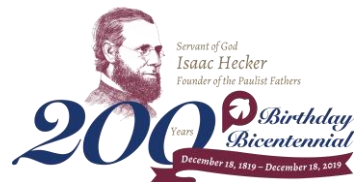
