### Interested In Becoming A Catholic

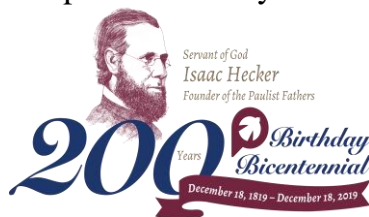
