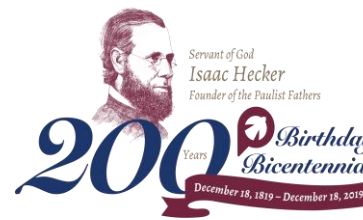
### Gift Cards
