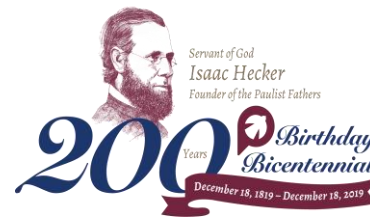

“Today is the twentieth anniversary of my baptism and reception into the Holy Church. To me my life has been one continued growth; and hence I have never had any desire to return to any part or period of it. This applies as well to my life before I was received into the Church as after. My best life was always in the present. It is also the nineteenth anniversary of my leaving for Europe to enter on my studies for the priesthood and missionary life.” (From an August 1864 Letter)
