JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY . . . SEASON OF LENT

December 8, 2015 to November 20, 2016

Pope Francis is asking that during this Jubilee Year, the season of Lent should be "lived more intensely as a privileged moment to celebrate and experience God's mercy."

REDISCOVER THE WORKS OF MERCY: Reflect on the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. The corporal works of mercy call us to feed the hungry give drink to the thirsty clothe the naked, welcome the stranger, heal the sick, visit the imprisoned, and bury the dead. The spiritual works of mercy beckon us to counsel the doubtful, instruct the ignorant, admonish sinners, comfort the afflicted, forgive offenses, bear patiently those who do us ill, and pray for the living and the dead. As you reflect on the works of mercy, ask yourself: what role do the works of mercy play in your life? In what ways they inspire you or beckon you to change?

LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE

During Lent, we are urged to reflect a spirit of penance in our daily lives through performing acts of faith and abstinence.

ABSTINENCE prohibits individuals from eating meat on a particular day. Abstinence obliges all those who have reached the age of 14 and continues to oblige throughout their lives. Those who are not specifically obliged to abstain from eating meat are encouraged to join in the discipline of abstaining to the extent that they are able.

Fridays in Lent are days of Abstinence.
