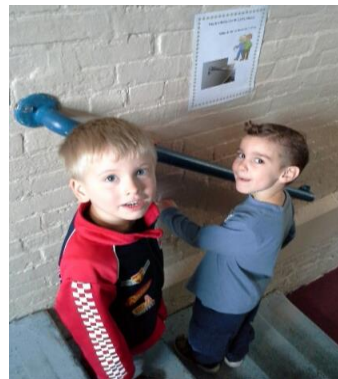
### FAITH FIRST CELEBRATES EARTH DAY
