**MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. DAY OF SERVICE  
JANUARY 15, 2018**

(Parish office is closed on Monday, January 15  
in observance of Martin Luther King Day)

The national Martin Luther King Day of Service was started by U.S. Senator Harris Wofford and Atlanta Congressman John Lewis, who co-authored the King Holiday and Service Act. The federal legislation challenges Americans to transform this holiday into a day of citizen action volunteer service in honor of King. Several universities and organizations around the U.S., hundreds of Volunteer Centers, and volunteers across the country donate their time to make a difference on this day. The only other official national day of service in the USA, as designated by the government, is September 11 National Day of Service (9/11 Day).
