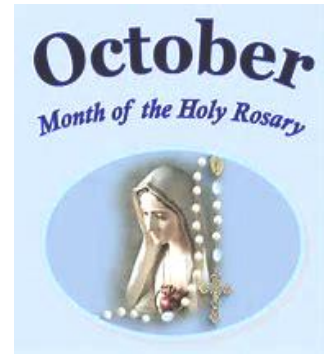

HOLY ROSARY
