

Ash Wednesday is a holy day of prayer, fasting and repentance. It is preceded by Shrove Tuesday and falls on the first day of Lent, the six weeks of penitence before Easter. Ash Wednesday derives its name from the placing of ashes on the foreheads of



participants to the words "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." Because it is the first day of Lent, many Christians, on Ash Wednesday, often begin marking a Lenten calendar, praying a Lenten daily devotional, and performing some sacrifice, perhaps a luxury that they will not partake in until Easter Sunday arrives.
