The archdiocese of Garoua is situated in the northern part of Cameroon, which is an arid area with scarcity of water and food. It is the least educated and less developed part of the country. In the bid to fight ignorance, unemployment, immoralities, street children phenomenon and poverty, the archdiocese of Garoua founded St Andrew's school in 2012 with its first classrooms built of straw. With the help of people of good will, we were able to put up a building of 4 classrooms. Now with more than 500 students, there is insufficiency of classrooms to accommodate all the students in order to properly educate them. The archdiocese of Garoua is a relatively young (just over 60 years old) and struggling diocese. Despite our good will and efforts, we are not able to build the school alone; that is why we have recourse to you our brothers and sisters of St Columba Church in Chester inviting you to extend your love and compassion to your brothers and sisters of that far away part of the world. The proceeds of the appeal will be used to build one or more classrooms to get those who still have classes under trees and straw classrooms to be sheltered and have proper eye contact with their teachers. We rely on your generosity. God bless and reward you abundantly.
