

## THE SCRIPTURE - February 25, 2018 **Second Sunday of Lent**

On this second Sunday of Lent, we hear the story of Jesus' Transfiguration. The scripture tells us that Jesus took Peter, James and John to the mountain. Elijah and Moses appeared and conversed with Jesus. Jesus was transfigured before their eyes and they heard a voice that said, "This is my beloved Son, listen to him." The disciples became afraid but acknowledged how good it is being there. Do you remember a time when someone or something changed before your eyes and even though you were afraid, you saw the beauty of that moment?

Jesus' transfiguration is a glimpse of transformation to which we are all called to experience in the resurrection. However, we are called to live day by day remembering that God is faithful to his promise. While we must endure many fears, hardships and pain on our journey of life, the only thing that will endure is God's love for us. We must hear God's voice in our lives saying, "you are my beloved." This is why the disciples said, "Lord is good for us to be here." No matter what's going on in your life, God is in control. Never lose heart. Do not be afraid. God's plan for our lives will always lead us through whatever we are experiencing. During this season of Lent, we are called to be the dream of God living in this world. Our transfiguration comes when we are willing to place before God all that binds us and keeps us from trusting him.

We need a revival. A moment to lift up our voices with strength and call on the name of the Lord. Let this moment be our moment of transfiguration. We ask God to break the chains that bind us! We ask God to speak a healing word into our lives. We ask God to lead us and guide us on this journey as we strive to change. Jesus is pardon for the sinner and a shepherd for the sheep. We are never alone. God's mission has a church and a people who seek what is right and just. We are his pilgrim people followers of Jesus, the one who God calls his beloved.
