Praying for the “poor souls” in Purgatory, however, is a requirement of Christian charity. Please consider attending holy Mass on All Souls Day. We have three Masses for your convenience.

With prayers for the dead in mind, please consider joining us next weekend for the blessing of the cemeteries. Saturday and Sunday will be full days of visiting these holy places where our beloved are resting.
