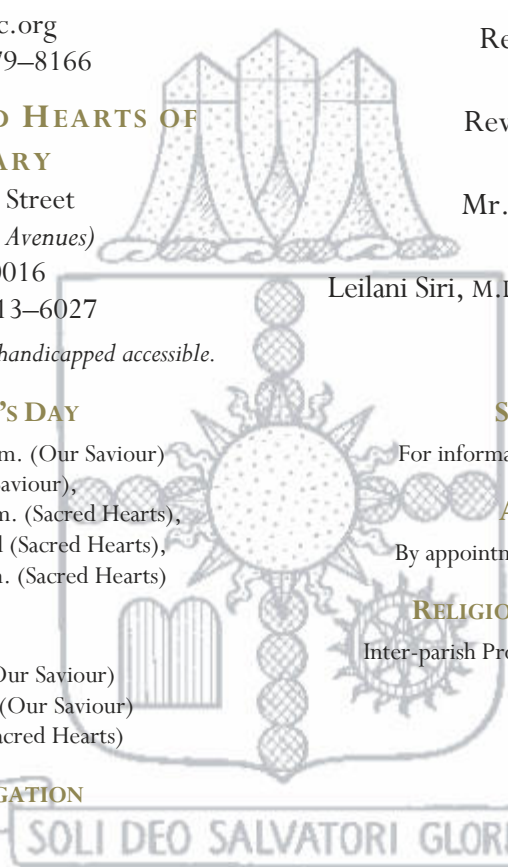

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Luke the Evangelist recounts that while Jesus, having received baptism, “was praying, the heaven was opened, and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form, as a dove, and a voice came from heaven, ‘You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased’” (*Luke 3:21–22*). This Jesus is the Son of God who is totally immersed in the will of the Father’s love. This Jesus is the One who will die on the cross and rise again through the power of the same Spirit who now descends upon him and consecrates him. This Jesus is the new man who wills to live as the son of God, that is, in love; the man who in the face of the evil of the world, by choosing the path of humility and responsibility he chooses not to save himself but to offer his own life for truth and justice. Being Christian means living like this, but this kind of life involves a rebirth: to be reborn from on high, from God, from Grace. This rebirth is the Baptism, which Christ gives to the Church in order to regenerate men and women to new life. An ancient text attributed to St Hippolytus states: “Whoever goes down into these waters of rebirth with faith renounces the devil and pledges himself to Christ. He repudiates the enemy and confesses that Christ is God, throws off his servitude, and is raised to filial status” (*Discourse on the Epiphany*, 10: PG 10, 862).

ORDINARY TIME

“Besides the times of the year that have their own distinctive character, there remains in the yearly cycle thirty-three or thirty-four weeks in which no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ itself is honored in its fullness, especially on Sundays. This period is known as Ordinary Time” (Universal Norms, 43). Ordinary Time begins on Monday, 14 January and continues through Tuesday, 5 March, the day before Ash Wednesday and the beginning of the Lenten season.

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

The 2019 Week of Prayer for Christian Unity theme finds its origins in Deuteronomy: “Justice, Only Justice, You Shall Pursue” (*cf. Deuteronomy 16:20*) was chosen for its powerful message of promoting truth, equality and unity. The traditional period in the northern hemisphere for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is 18–25 January. Those dates were proposed in 1908 by the Servant of God, Fr. Paul Wattson, S.A., Founder of the Society of the Atonement, to cover the original days of the feasts of the Chair of St. Peter (18 January) and the Conversion of St. Paul (25 January), and therefore have a symbolic significance. Please pray for the unity of all Christians this week.
