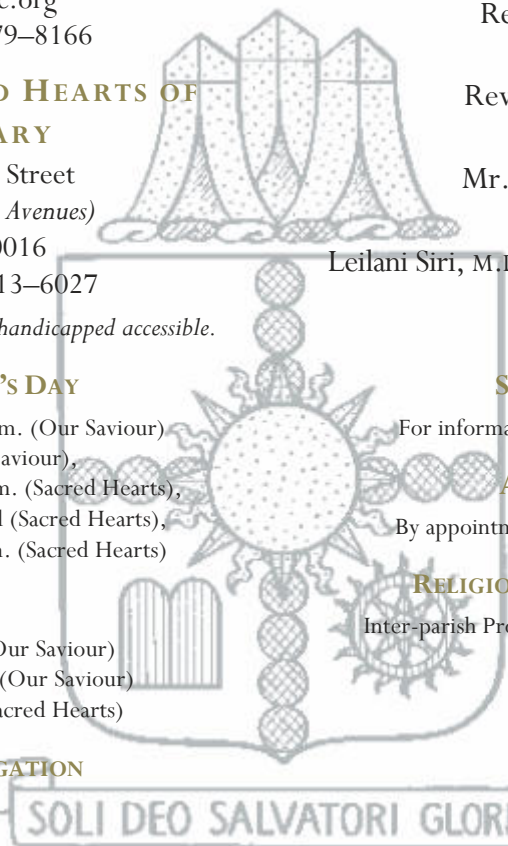

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

Blessed are they that have not seen. Now under these circumstances it seemed reasonable that our Lord should give them the testimony of sight, touch, etc., for, unless some one saw him again, how were the apostles, how was the world to know it.

But a deeper lesson. Sight could not be given to all, because our Lord was going to heaven, and those who did not see must believe on the witness of others. Now the Gospel was to last to the end of the world. Therefore He in His love determined that one of the apostles should be away and not see Him.

This was Thomas, who, being in the state of confusion which they all were in before they saw Him, persisted in that unbelief which at first they all had. When the women testified, Thomas would not believe.

We all know what happened. Our Lord graciously ... said: "Blessed are they that have not seen and have believed."

This is one lesson Our Lord speaks to us. Thomas thought it hard he had not the evidence the rest had. *He was not content with what was sufficient.* This *the great lesson.* Doubtless sight is more than the witness of other men.
