SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

From Luke, and especially from John, we know that Jesus, during the Last Supper, also prayed to the Father – prayers which also contain a plea to his disciples of that time and of all times. Here I would simply like to take one of these which, as John tells us, Jesus repeated four times in his Priestly Prayer. How deeply it must have concerned him! It remains his constant prayer to the Father on our behalf: the prayer for unity. Jesus explicitly states that this prayer is not meant simply for the disciples then present, but for all who would believe in him. He prays that all may be one “as you, Father, are in me and I am in you, so that the world may believe”. Christian unity can exist only if Christians are deeply united to him, to Jesus.

NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

In these days leading to Pentecost (9 June) the Novena to the Holy Spirit is prayed, recalling Jesus’s promise to the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Apostles that he would send the Holy Spirit as their helper. We pray: Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created and you shall renew the face of the earth. Amen.

RED FOR PENTECOST

Next Sunday is Pentecost, the fiftieth day of the Easter Season. In the Roman Rite, red vestments are worn on Pentecost, in reference to the flames of fire that came down upon the Apostles, as well as the “burning charity” that arose in them after that day. We encourage *everybody* to wear red to Mass next Sunday, as we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit, not only on the Apostles, but upon us, as well.

Remembering someone with a **MASS INTENTION** honors them in a unique way – surrounding them with the warmth of God’s love. A Mass may be offered for the living or deceased, for a birthday, anniversary, for somebody who is ill, or for a special intention. The stipend for a Mass intention is \$15.
